

## **GUIDELINES FOR JUST A MINUTE (JAM)**

- Each member can submit a total of TWO abstracts only under JAM as a Presenting Author
- The abstract should be submitted through the conference website portal.
- The title SHOULD NOT exceed 100 characters (including spaces), and a synopsis SHOULD NOT exceed 1000 characters (including spaces).
- Institution/hospital affiliation and doctor's name should NOT be mentioned in the title or abstract. Any form of non-compliance will lead to automatic rejection.
- The abstract can be submitted under any one of the following categories:
  - Cataract
  - Cornea
  - Refractive Surgery
  - Glaucoma
  - Paediatric Ophthalmology and strabismus
  - Vitreo-Retinal Diseases

- Comprehensive Ophthalmology
- Orbit & Oculoplasty
- Neuro-Ophthalmology
- Uvea
- If the Presenting Author is not a member or not enrolled as a Life Member of the TNOA on (or) before May 31<sup>st</sup> 2026, the opportunity to present in the conference will be given to the next eligible member by the selection committee of each subspecialty.
- No change in the presenting author will be entertained after the selection of the abstract after June 15th.
- Co-authors: A maximum of two co-authors can be added.
- Appropriate platforms will be arranged, where all the selected abstracts will be presented during the conference, and a selected panel will discuss the presentation for **1 minute with an interesting learning pearl.**
- Presentations selected for each sub-speciality session will be presented during the conference as a part of a separate session or in between the symposiums, which will be intimated to the participants from the scientific committee.

- The presentation can be a video of a surgical procedure or a PowerPoint presentation of an interesting case discussion similar to video-assisted skill transfer (VAST).
- The presentation will be judged according to Content, Display, Scientific value, Creativity and Originality by a selected panel from each sub-specialty for selection criteria.
